

Perfect place to potter about

THE latest development in Officer was launched last month, with 221 lots on 14ha released to the public.

Potters Grove is a \$45m project from Integrated Development, fronting Princes Highway and on the doorstep of Beaconsfield. It follows the success of Fairview, the company's residential development in Mernda.

Director Jeff Garvey said Potters Grove was perfectly placed to benefit from the well-established amenities in the region.

"Potters Grove lies between Berwick and Officer and is within easy distance of facilities such as childcare centres and a selection of public and private schools to cater for every family's needs," he said.

Haileybury College's Berwick campus is 7km from Potters Grove and Monash University is an eight-minute drive.

Lots range from 320sq m to 673sq m, and are priced between \$169,000 and \$222,000.

Potters Grove, named in tribute to the Berwick Pottery business nearby, also boasts a range of

transport options, with Officer railway station 900m away.

The development will have the infrastructure necessary for rollout of the National Broadband Network (NBN). Residents will also have access to recycled water.

As well as a 1ha park, Potters Grove is also close to the Wilson Botanic Gardens.
